Format: Lecture, observation of patient treatment, and hands-on fabrication of various arch wires (typodont). Hands-on exercises include fabrication of distal offsets, active tiebacks, intrusion arches and expansion arches.

Lecture Topics:

- 1) Diagnosis and management of sleep apnea and airway problems in children
- 2) Sagittal first orthodontic treatment-when to use it and when not to use it. This also includes a discussion on alternatives to this treatment protocol
- 3) Innovative uses of Triad composite in orthodontic treatment.
- 4)Uprighting Springs-how to fabricate them and how to use them.
- 5)Early treatment-management of malocclusions with a 2 x 4 set up

Course description: this course will serve as an update for clinicians who have previously attended the 4 day advanced mechanics course.

Tuition: \$900. If the tuition is paid in full before February 1, 2019, the tuition is reduced to \$800. A down payment of \$500 is required to reserve a spot in the course. Doctors will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis.
